**TELEPHONE CONVERSATION BETWEEN THE PRESIDENT AND JUSTICE
GOLDBERG (from Justice Goldberg)**

LBJ: Yes?

AG: Mr. President?

LBJ: Yes sir.

AG: No... I'm calling you.

LBJ: Fine. Well, I was going to call you.

AG: I want to tell you that it was just right and congratulations.

LBJ: Well you're nice. I hoped you noticed that your "hats" line got the biggest applause.

AG: But... you did it in good tone and just right. And, I'm chiling for another purpose. I want you to get a day's rest tomorrow.

LBJ: All right. Fine. I'm going to.

AG: Do that... after all, you've been hitting it pretty hard and you've been going through a pretty rough period... and ..take a day off.

LBJ: I'll do it. Give my love to Dorothy. I wanted to call you. I told them to get you... early... I thought this was my call... but it will save me making one. I just wanted to tell you that I sure appreciate your suggestions and I thought they were good..

AG: All right... listen... anything I can do to help... you know that. You're mighty busy and I won't bother you..

LBJ: I know... give me some ideas

AG: was Mrs. Kennedy's request with the Russian Ambassador.. which I want to bring you up to date on.. but..

LBJ: All right... some day... as soon as we get moved in.. we'll get Dorothy and you down here and we can visit.

AG: Fine... and you take a day's rest now and give my best to Lady Bird.

LBJ: Will do. Bye
