**TELEPHONE CONVERSATION BETWEEN THE PRESIDENT AND
PROFESSOR ERIC GOLDMAN (to Professor Goldman)**

LBJ: Hello... Professor Goldman?

LBJ Thank you so much and we need help more than we ever did before and we thank you so much for your attitude.
